LEGAL BACKGROUND - PPP ACT OF 2008 - KEY ISSUES

- "Public-private partnership is joint implementation of a project based on division of tasks and risks between the public entity and the private partner" (art. 1)
- Pre-realization analysis (evaluation of efficiency of the project concerned)
- Framework provisions (but adjusted to PPP specifics after amendments in 2018)
- National classification of the contracts recorded balance-on/balance-off sheet



LEGAL BACKGROUND – CONCESSIONS ACT OF 2016 - KEY ISSUES

- The concessionaire bears the economic risk related to the exploitation of a work or a service and the risks related to demand and supply
- Non-flexible contracts
- Flexible procedure which causes a lot of problems
- Much better to use the PPP Act of 2008



LEGAL BACKGROUND - INTERDEPENDENCE



- From the beginning of 2009 to March 31, 2019, a total of 551 ppp proceedings were initiated. Of all the concluded contracts, 134 entered the implementation phase.
- In the first quarter of 2019, two contracts worth PLN 53 million were signed. During this period, four proceedings were initiated with a total value of approx. PLN 40 million - two in the energy sector, one in the energy efficiency and education sectors.

Najwięcej umów PPP realizowanych jest w sektorach: infrastruktura transportowa (21), sport i turystyka (20), efektywność energetyczna (20).

Pod względem wartości dominują dwa sektory: 28% stanowią projekty z sektora telekomunikacji, a 24% projekty dotyczące gospodarki odpadami.



At the same time, at the end of the first quarter of 2019, a total of 140 investment plans were identified at various stages of preparation, of which 74% of projects are in the phase prior to the announcement of the procedure, i.e. at the stage of the idea, effectiveness assessment or selection of an adviser. The remaining 26% are pending private partner selection procedures. Among them, the most investments are at the stage of negotiations



- ✤ 40% of contracts are concessions for services
- ✤ 34% of contracts are based on availability payments
- 13% of contracts are "PPP in a mode of concession"
- 11% of contracts are concessions for works
- 2% of contacts other legal basis



- ✤ 90% of contracts are signed by the local govnerment units
- Only 7 governmental contracts (including 6 concessions for services...)
- 5 contracts = value of 50% of the contracts
- Small PPPs with capex under 40 mln PLN (80% of all!)
- Less than 50% of public entities engages external advisors
- On average one of four procedures ends with the PPP contract

INSTITUTIONAL SUPPORT

- Ministry of Investment and Economic Development acts as a central coordinating and management unit for PPPs in Poland
- MIED provides complex advisory services for public entities and issue opinions on whether it is useful to apply the PPP formula for a specific investment ("PPP certification")
- MIED aims to develop and disseminate guidelines, recommendations, good practices facilitating the preparation and implementation of PPP
- MIED keeps a data base of investment plans (PPP project pipeline) and a data base of signed PPPs; they continuously monitor their performance
- MIED carries out educational and information activities, e.g. trainings, specialist workshops and study visits
