

International Convention on Simplification and Harmonization of Customs Procedures – Kyoto Convention

- delivery of goods under the customs control without guarantee for payment Θ of customs duties
- storage of goods on the AEO's warehouses Θ
- involvement of goods in economic turnover before presenting the customs 0 declaration and payment of customs duties
- independent use of sealing devices in order to identify the goods and 0 transport vehicles
- priority granted while transporting the goods across the customs border 6 Θ




Kyoto Convention

The Republic of Belarus became the 72nd Contracting Party to the International Convention on Simplification and Harmonization of Customs Procedures (Kyoto Convention)


The Convention is a model for effective and modern customs procedures addressing the up-to-date challenges. The Convention has entered into force for the Republic of Belarus since 10th April 2011

E- declaration system (EDS): A platform for Customs-Business relationships




Implementation of all without exception customs procedures in the e-declaration system export e-declarations on goods – 96% import e-declarations on goods – 89%


Automatic registration of statistics declarations

Introduction of application principle elements


• Transparency of the registration process, automatic and promptly informing of economic operators about this process have been ensured

Significant reduction of time needed to register the statistics and goods declarations



Performance of customs operations




While performing customs operations the authorized officer is empowered, where necessary, to perform extra operations of customs control in case when:

Risk profile occurs

- auto-detection of a risk profile in software
- detection of a risk profile by an officer performing customs operations



X-Ray Scanning System





- A single form of the transit declaration, harmonized with the corresponding document of the European Union
- As a transit declaration is possible to use the transport documents, the package of documents required by the Convention on international road transport and temporary import of goods, documents of the Universal Postal Union.
- When crossing the Belarusian-Russian and Russian-Kazakh border carrier is not faced with the need to pass customs control and to issue national transit declaration




Customs clearance points

Republican customs clearance points – 61, including:

- ➤ road 24;
- ➤ railway 16;
- > at airports -7;
- > at simplified crossing points -3;
- > at transfer railway stations -9;
- > at river ports -3.
